



NON-RESIDENT BORROWING PRIVILEGES

Individuals who are not residents of the Glenwood Lynwood Public Library District or of any other public library, and for whom this library is the “closest public library” may purchase a one-year non-resident card for a fee equal to that paid by the average homeowner of the library district.

This fee is calculated using the General Mathematical Formula (23 Ad. Code 3050.60(a) established by the Illinois State Library. The fee is calculated and adopted each year by the Library Trustees.

The card is valid for twelve months.

A non-resident who owns property in Glenwood or Lynwood can obtain 1 GWS library card at no charge. The following criteria must be met before issuing the library card:

- Must show proof that they pay taxes in the communities of Glenwood or Lynwood, by presenting their most current tax bill and a current photo ID.
- If they are a business renter (rent a storefront or property for business) it is implied that the rent paid to the owner goes towards property taxes, therefore they too are eligible for 1 library card.

A valid non-resident library card holder is allowed all the services the Library provides to its residents including reciprocal borrowing and interlibrary loan privileges.
